

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. WHAT IS WORLD PARKINSON'S DAY?

World Parkinson's Day is held on 11 April every year. It marks the birthday of Dr James Parkinson, who is most famous for publishing 'An Essay on the Shaking Palsy' in 1817 and establishing Parkinson's as an internationally recognised medical condition.

2017 marks 200 years since the essay was published. This provides the perfect opportunity for the international Parkinson's community - including people affected, healthcare professionals and Parkinson's organisations around the world - to join together to raise awareness about the condition and that 200 years is too long without a cure.

On 11 April 2017 we are asking everyone, no matter where they are around the world, to unite and raise awareness about Parkinson's on a bigger scale than ever before.

2. WHAT IS THE OVERALL AIM OF THE **#UNITEFORPARKINSONS CAMPAIGN?**

The main aim of the #UniteForParkinsons campaign is to raise awareness of Parkinson's and the global Parkinson's community. It is the first stage in a longer-term plan - we want to position World Parkinson's Day as a platform to grow an active Parkinson's community beyond 2017. With a bigger community we can encourage a bigger focus on Parkinson's and the need for more collaborative research and development around the world.

It is important to make our first campaign a success - and we are hoping to have at least 50 countries take part in #UniteForParkinsons. Will you help us reach this target? By using the campaign hashtag, logo and messages, you will be raising awareness wherever you are in the world.

If you want to do more in your area, contact your local Parkinson's organisation.

3.WHO IS BEHIND THE 'UNITE FOR PARKINSON'S' CAMPAIGN?

Parkinson's UK and the European Parkinson's Disease Association (EPDA) have been working together to develop the #UniteForParkinsons concept and this guide.

People affected by Parkinson's and Parkinson's organisations from around the world have also been involved. We have had vital input and support from people and organisations in Denmark, Finland, Greece, India, Ireland, Luxemburg, Malta, New Zealand, Norway, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, the UK and the US.

You will notice that the guide and visuals are not aligned to the Parkinson's UK or EPDA brand identities. This is deliberate: #UniteForParkinsons is for everyone affected by Parkinson's around the world.

- 'Come to our meeting/event on 11 April. Raise awareness and #UniteForParkinsons'

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

5.I DON'T USE SOCIAL MEDIA, What else can i do to help?

We understand that not everyone is on social media. However, we chose this as our main way to communicate because it reaches people internationally very quickly, easily and cheaply.

However, there are many other simple 'offline' ways to support the campaign. For example:

- Taking part in an event to raise awareness and/ or fundraise for your local organisation using the #UniteForParkinsons campaign materials.
- Writing an article for a local/national magazine or contacting your local/national newspaper

- Using the printable image (page 9) to create badges/stickers/other merchandise use them at events or add them to your own materials.
- Putting a poster in your window.

6.WILL THERE BE INTERNATIONAL PARTNERSHIPS IN FUTURE?

We hope so. This campaign is the first stage towards bringing the global Parkinson's community together through collaboration. We will use what we have learned from this first campaign to look at ways we can continue to work together for future World Parkinson's Days and consider other opportunities that may arise.
